Wounded U.S. Army Veteran to Receive Specially Adapted Home in Rancho Sahuarita

Sahuarita, Ariz. – October 23, 2024 – Members of Rancho Sahuarita joined with longtime community homebuilder, Lennar and non-profit organization Helping a Hero on October 1st to celebrate the groundbreaking of an adaptive home for U.S. Army veteran Sergeant Tanner House. The home is part of the Helping a Hero 100 Homes Challenge and has been specially adapted to meet his unique mobility needs following a severe spinal injury sustained during his military service in Afghanistan.

Sergeant House, who was injured during a resupply mission, has faced numerous challenges in his transition to civilian life, including homelessness. His new three-bedroom, two-bathroom home will be fully equipped with wider doorways, a roll-in shower, and other accessibility modifications. This home will provide him with the freedom to live independently and safely while continuing his personal mission to help fellow veterans heal through outdoor activities.

"This home is a dream come true," said Sergeant House.
